If anyone has input on this topic I need to hear from them ASAP so that an informed decision can be made.

I know riding year round can be a challenge when the weather takes a turn for the worse. As riders (and all of our Road Captains especially) we need to be on the lookout for all the dangers out in front of us and point these out to those following behind. During inclement weather, we need to increase our following distance and look out for the entire group. Remember to check your mirrors often too, especially if you are riding directly in front of the sweep rider. If something happens in the back of the group, we ask that you get the info up to the rider(s) in front of you and let the lead Road Captain find a place to get the group off the road to determine a plan of action. That's why the Captains get paid the big bucks, hold it, I think this is a job without pay, but it is also one with lots of FUN attached to it too.

I have about seven people in ready to go through the Experienced Rider Course and need twelve. This is a course that emphasizes the basic skills and teaches advanced skills in balancing and counter balancing, handling obstacles and surprises, swerving and braking, and can be challenging yet fun. If you have been riding for a long time, it can refresh you on those things you don't practice routinely too. Moreover, if you take the course, you are qualified to be a Road Captain, though you don't have to be. For \$25 out of your pocket, it is a great deal. See me for more details.
