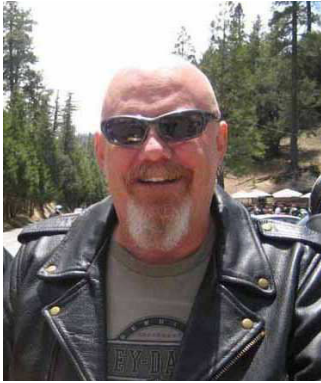

First let me remind you all that Safety is every ones job, not just the Road Captain or Sweep Rider.

By every rider staying alert and riding within their abilities we can enjoy another great year on the road. We have a good group of riders, our road captains are experienced knowledgeable lead riders.

If you are new to group riding we have a video that comes from the Riders Edge / Motorcycle Safety Foundation that only takes about 20 minutes to watch and is packed full of good advice and an overview of the basics of Group Riding. This video covers pretty much everything from Preparation, the Riders meeting, Hand signals, Riding formations, How to keep the Group together. What to do at intersections. The Video has suggestions on Group Parking, Passing, Roadside Emergencies, and Roadway Hazards.

We also have the Group Riding Handbook. Another jewel for you to look through with good sound advice on the how to and what not to does. The video and Handbook are available to all members at no cost. Please don't hesitate to ask me for a copy.

I want to remind you of the Motorcycle Classes offered by our sponsoring Dealership. If you have not attended a safety class before now, they are offered on a regular basis and well worth your time. No matter how long you have been riding you are sure to learn something from the class to make you a Better / Safer Rider.

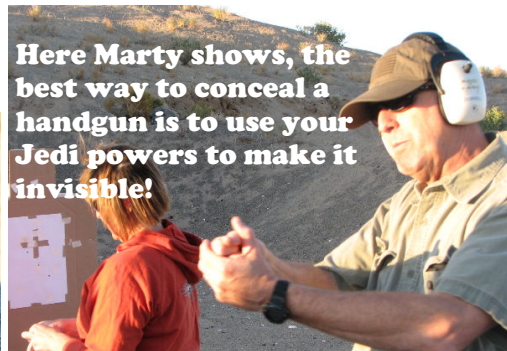
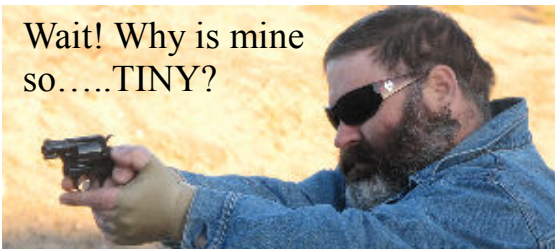


Hello Friends,
